

WAUKESHA USBC HALL OF FAME

PURPOSE:

Waukesha USBC (the Association) shall operate a hall of fame for members of the Association who have made a significant contribution to the sport of bowling. Bowlers who have made been members of the Association for a minimum of 15 years and have made a significant contribution to the Association through their performance and/or service will be recognized the Association.

BOWLERS SHALL BE SELECTED TO THE HALL OF FAME IN THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:

SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE: Candidates will be evaluated based on high scores and high averages in league, and wins or places in local tournaments, state tournaments and national tournaments.

MERITORIOUS SERVICE: Candidates will be evaluated based on distinguished service over a period of years to promote the sport of bowling. Service includes offices held with the local association, league officer, committees served on at the local, state, or national level, coaching, and any special honors received at the local, state, or national level.

RING OF HONOR: People who have promoted the sport of bowling in a manner that does not fall under the meritorious category. Some examples are proprietors, sponsors, coordinators, supervisors, etc.

PRE-REQUISITES FOR MEMBERSHIP:

The following pre-requisite is essential for all nominations to the Waukesha USBC Hall of Fame.

- 1) Active participation in a certified bowling league in the Waukesha USBC Association for a period of fifteen (15) or more years (does not need to be consecutive).

In addition, candidates in the Superior Performance category must also meet the following pre-requisites:

- 1) Candidates in the Superior Performance category must have bowled in tournaments held by Waukesha USBC for a minimum of 10 years (does not need to be consecutive), and,
- 2) Have had a league average of at least 210 (men) or 190 (women) for at least 7 years (does not need to be consecutive).

APPLICATIONS:

Applications can be submitted by any member of the Waukesha USBC Association, the Waukesha USBC Board of Directors, or the Hall of Fame committee in writing. The application must contain all facts and figures vital and necessary to satisfy investigation of the information by the Hall of Fame Nominations Committee.
